

Wireless Agreement Policy

I. PURPOSE

To establish a written policy with regard to the use of Parkston Public Library wireless internet access.

II. POLICY

The Parkston Public Library (“the library”) provides free wireless Internet access via an open, unsecured wireless network. By using this free service, you agree to abide by the Library’s Internet Use Policy.

III. DEFINITIONS

- A. Security: precautions taken to guard against crime, attack, sabotage, espionage, etc.
- B. Virus Protection: Virus protection software is designed to prevent viruses, worms, and Trojan horses from getting onto a computer as well as remove any malicious software code that has already infected a computer.
- C. Liability: Being responsible for something.

IV. ADMINISTRATION

- A. Sites in this collection are selected based on the usefulness, relevancy, quality, and currency of the contents, and the navigability and ease of use of the site's design. Sites included should have an identifiable content authority, be reliably and freely accessible, be updated frequently, and be easy to use. A search engine or other form of index to the site's contents is desirable.
- B. A Library link to an external website does not constitute an endorsement or affiliation by the Library to the site or its sponsors. The Library cannot control or monitor other material which may be accessible from Internet sources. Individual users must accept responsibility for determining the content of Internet resources.
